After a cuppa tea it's onto Forbes, stopping at the information centre (staff are helpful) and tour around town looking at the street sculptures. Last time we looked at the art found along the Lachlan River, it's a great cultural asset to the region.

Tonight we stop at West Wyalong Caravan Park, the sky is clear and a strong cool westerly is blowing - cooler weather on the way.
